**Professional Learning Day Plan – September 19, 2025**  
**Queen Elizabeth School**



The following is a brief description of our planned professional learning work for September 19. This work is organized around our district's four collective goals:

- All students shall read, write, and communicate at grade level in both languages of instruction.
- All students shall be at grade level in numeracy.
- All students and staff will feel safe, cared for, and engaged in learning.
- All students shall graduate from high school.

School staff will monitor the impact of their work from September 19, and on subsequent professional learning days, in achieving these goals.

**Literacy**

- K–8 teachers will learn to implement WIN (What I Need) blocks, grouping students flexibly for targeted support.
- Teachers will design purposeful learning stations and learn to embed scaffolding strategies into daily practice.

**Numeracy**

- Middle school math teachers will explore the holistic curriculum and plan to implement WIN (What I Need) blocks in math.
- Specialty teachers will embed literacy and numeracy strategies into their subject areas.

**Safe, Cared For, and Engaged**

- Educational Assistants will strengthen their role in building independence and engagement amongst students in the classrooms they are working in.

**Graduation**

- Staff will plan interventions and strategies to increase the number of students meeting grade-level expectations by providing targeted interventions that support long-term graduation success.
